It's a heady and seductive wine full of complexity. Aromas of dried red plums, red and black currants, cedar, tobacco and dried herbs</i>			70
<b>Nuits-St. Georges 1er Cru 'Clos des Argillières' Dom. Rion, Burgundy, France, 2012</b> <i>Dense, dark purple with an outstanding bouquet of dark fruit, it is very concentrated. There is a superb depth of fruit throughout and yet it is very well balanced, even silky behind.</i>			75
<b>Barolo, Cascina Fontana, Piedmont, Italy, 2013</b> <i>The vines are situated in Castiglione Falletto and this Nebbiolo oozes with flavors of cherry, black fruits, and smoke, showing great balance despite its richness.</i>			85
<b>Château Batailley, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France, 2007</b> <i>Named after a 'bataille' that was fought here between the French and English (who else) 600 years ago this is quintessential Pauillac. its toasty, ripe plum and cedar nose leads on to a palate with vivid cassis and raspberry fruit, creamy vanilla oak and a lovely long finish.</i>			90
